



The National Confidential Enquiry into Patient Outcome and Death (NCEPOD) commenced work in 1988 and identifies remediable factors in anaesthesia, surgery and medicine in adults and children.

Developing a detailed understanding of NCEPOD and our methods you will be able to provide the ongoing patient and public voice at NCEPOD and support individual, study-specific patients.

As examples, but not exclusively, tasks would include:

- Participating in Study Advisory Groups
- Reviewing the data
- Providing a lay and patient perspective on the reports.

This position would be for one year initially, and renewable on an annual basis thereafter.

The successful candidates will be asked to attend the NCEPOD office in London as required but on average about twice per month.

NCEPOD will reimburse all travel expenses.
