Based on case note reviews, routinely collected national data and surveys, the report focuses on the quality of care provided to young people aged 11 to 25 years old with depression, anxiety, eating disorder and/or who self-harm. Transition from child to adult services and the interface between different services are key themes.

Speakers representing some of the professional groups involved will lead the discussion on the impact of the findings and how the recommendations can be implemented.
