This launch will discuss the findings of NCEPOD's latest study which explored remediable factors in the process of care of elderly patients who died within 30 days of emergency or elective surgery

The main areas that this study covered are:

- Fluid management
- The seniority of clinicians involved in intra-operative care
- Delays in surgery (due to scheduling, and the management of the patients physical status)
- Anaesthetic management including pre-operative assessment
- Acute pain management
- Post operative cognitive dysfunction
- Use of Critical Care facilities
- Nutrition
- Comorbidities
- Medications including thromboembolism prophylaxis
- Consent
- Prevention of peri-operative hypothermia
