



Transition from child to adult services study

- NCEPOD is undertaking a study to explore the barriers and facilitators in the process of the transition of young people with complex chronic conditions from child to adult health services
- Young people aged between 13 years and their 25th birthday with a complex chronic condition, transitioning from child to adult health services will be included in the study. Twelve conditions have been chosen as a means of identifying a broad sample of young people with a complex chronic condition for inclusion in the study
- Retrospective study period: **1st October 2019 – 31st March 2021 inclusive**
- **Patients will be identified retrospectively for the study in primary, community, secondary and tertiary care settings** via completion of a patient identification spreadsheet
- **Two clinical questionnaires will be used to collect clinical data for this study:**
 - **Primary care questionnaire**
 - **Community, physical, and mental healthcare questionnaire**
- An organisational questionnaire will collect data on the organisation of services, networks of care and multidisciplinary team working, the commissioning of services, the use of guidelines and protocols and training
- **Clinical reviewers will be recruited for the peer review of case notes.** Please email: transition@ncepod.org.uk for more information
