

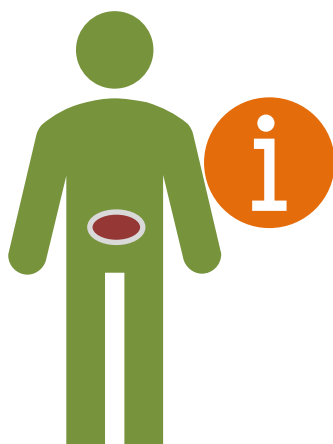

A survey will also be open to healthcare professionals to ask for their opinions on training and delivery of care.

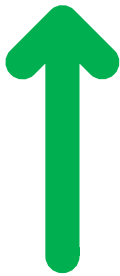


Patient's clinical notes that relate to the admission for acute sigmoid volvulus treatment, will be collected and reviewed by other doctors and other healthcare professionals.
